

TOWN COMPREHENSIVE DRAFT PLAN ONLINE, PUBLIC WORKSHOP IS THIS MONDAY, 1/28

The draft of the Town's Comprehensive Plan Update can be found online at www.PittsfordPlan.com. The community workshop for the Town of Pittsford's Comprehensive Plan process will take place this Monday, January 28 from 6:00 - 9:00pm at the Pittsford Fire Department Station #2, 465 Mendon Road.

The Town's Comprehensive Plan Committee and its consultant, Bergmann Associates, will present the draft Comprehensive Plan for public comment. The Comprehensive Plan Workshop is an opportunity for residents to share views and ideas about the Town's draft Comprehensive Plan. The draft plan was shaped by community input at public workshops held at the beginning of the process. The plan's Citizen Committee took this input and worked with the consultant to create the draft plan. The public workshop is to solicit views of residents on the draft before it goes to the Town Board for consideration and adoption.

Community engagement in comprehensive planning is indispensable to getting the plan right and applying it successfully over time, with public support. If you can't make the meeting you can comment online. However we value hearing from residents in person and from a variety of viewpoints. We hope you can join us for this important meeting, as we bring a very thorough public process to its conclusion.

PINK THE RINK RESCHEDULED TO THIS THURSDAY AT RIT'S RITTER RINK | JANUARY 24

Due to the winter storm last week, the Pittsford Central School District's "Pink the Rink" charity hockey games have been rescheduled to a new date and location. The games will now take place this Thursday, January 24 (tomorrow) at the Frank Ritter Ice Arena at Rochester Institute of Technology. The Pittsford JV and Varsity Panthers ice hockey teams will battle the Webster Schroeder Warriors in the **10th annual Pink the Rink games to benefit cancer research**. The JV game begins at 5:00pm, followed by the Varsity game at 7:00pm. As is tradition, the Pittsford athletes will wear special pink jerseys!

Pink the Rink has been a Pittsford School District tradition since 2010 and has raised \$56,829 for the Breast Cancer Coalition of Rochester. Friends of Pittsford Hockey Board Member Celeste Frohm proposed the idea for Pink the Rink after watching her son play in a similar event at the State University of New York at Fredonia. Frohm believed it would be an effective way to bring the Pittsford community together for a worthy cause.

REMINDER: CHRISTMAS TREE RECYCLING UNDERWAY

Weather permitting, the Town of Pittsford's Highway Department continues to pick up Christmas trees that have not been taken by residential services. Please place your tree curbside and remove any plastic bagging and all decorations. Christmas trees may also be dropped off at the Highway Garage, 60 Golf Avenue, from 7:00am until dark, Monday through Saturday. All trees gathered will be chipped and reused as mulch. The mulch will be available free to residents in the spring at the East Street storage site located just before the gate to the Town Parks Department office building (enter at 34 East Street).

PROPERTY TAX PAYMENTS DUE BY 2/10, EXTENDED OFFICE HOURS ON FEBRUARY 8

The interest-free Town and County property tax payment deadline is February 10; first installments or full payment of your Town and County property taxes are due at this time. To assist taxpayers, the Town Clerk will extend office hours, for tax payments only, from 8:00am to 6:00pm on Friday, February 8. For residents paying property tax bills at Town Hall (11 South Main Street), 10 minute parking will be available in the parking lot behind the building on Friday, February 8. The payment stub (see page 2 of your tax bill) must accompany payment.

First installment payments and full payments also may be made at Canandaigua National Bank (18 State Street, Pittsford) through Saturday, February 9 only.

February 10 falls on a Sunday (when Town Hall is not open), therefore, payment will be accepted as received "on-time" if received in person at Town Hall on Monday, February 11 or with a U.S. postmark of Monday, February 11, 2019. Payments may be made <u>online</u> by February 10 using Visa or MasterCard only; please note there is a 3% service charge for online payments. <u>To pay online click this link</u>, which directs to the Monroe County Property Tax portal.

It is also **strongly** advised that you do NOT pay by electronic check, as these payments do not receive a U.S. postmark and may arrive late. The payment stub (see page 2 of your tax bill) must accompany your payment.

Please also note: If you are paying your tax bill with an online bill pay (electronic banking) system through your bank, please be aware that your bank still generates and mails a paper check to the Town and it may take as long as two weeks or more to reach the Town offices. This type of mail does not receive a USPS postmark. Therefore, the Town can only consider your payment received on the date it is physically received in our office.

SEASONAL PARKING RESTRICTIONS IN EFFECT THROUGH APRIL 1, 2019

In order to facilitate snow removal Town of Pittsford seasonal parking restrictions are in effect from November 15 (this Thursday) through April 1, 2019. Parking of any vehicle on public roads - including state highways and on the shoulder of all roads - is prohibited each year from November 15 through April 1 in all areas within the Town and outside of the Village. Please note violators may be ticketed or towed. Help us keep our roadways safe - during this time, please don't park on or along public roads outside of the Village.
