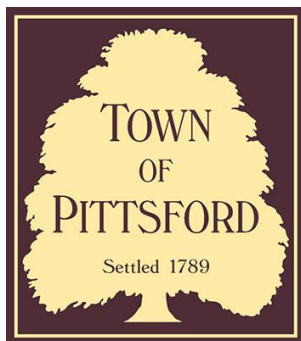
JOIN US FOR AN RPO COMMUNITY CONCERT JULY 28!

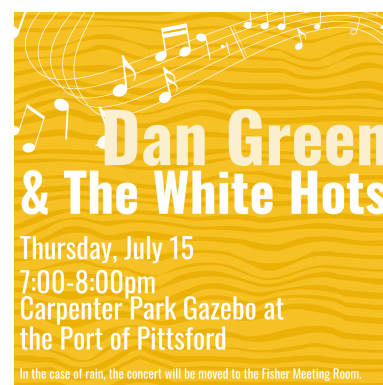
Applications due July 30

CELEBRATING THE MILEPOST-STONETOWN HISTORIC DISTRICT

The Town has placed banners in the MilePost-Stonetown Historic District to celebrate this historic part of our community and to increase public awareness of it. In 1991 the Town's Historic Preservation Commission designated the area as a local historic district. This year we mark its 30th anniversary.

Located south of the Village where Main Street, Stone Road, Mendon Road, and Mendon Center Road meet, the district includes some of the earliest properties settled in the Town. These include the Lusk Farmstead and a historic residence on Mendon Center Road, the oldest

house in Pittsford on Stone Road, the Pioneer Burying Ground and Mile Post Schoolhouse #1 on Mendon Road, and a historic residence on Main Street. All contribute to the distinctive character of the district because of their historic and architectural significance. The more recent Founders Green and Cross Meadow Lane also are sited within the MilePost-Stonetown Historic District.

By definition, a historic district comprises a formally-designated group of buildings, structures, sites, and spaces that relate to one another historically, architecturally, or culturally. The MilePost-Stonetown district stands as a visual reminder of Pittsford's heritage and character.

The Town's Design Review and Historic Preservation Board – successor to the Historic Preservation Commission that created the district – proposed and designed the banners and the Supervisor and Town Board approved the project. "At a time when too many other communities were bulldozing their heritage and paving it over, Pittsford appreciated the value to the entire community of historic preservation," noted Supervisor Bill Smith. "Special thanks to the members of our Design Review and Historic Preservation Board for carrying on this work so important to the integrity of

our community's fabric."

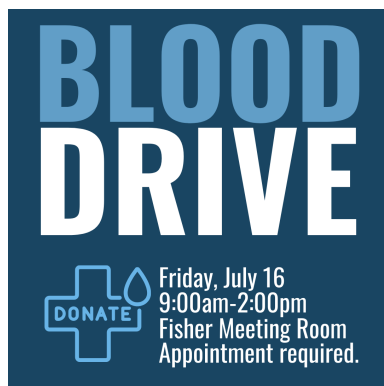
At present, MilePost-Stonetown is the only local historic district in the Town of Pittsford. A number of other neighborhoods are eligible for local historic district designation pending a future review of the current preservation code, as recommended in the Town Comprehensive Plan Update

your arrival to help ensure we can safely manage the flow of donors.

The Red Cross will be following all current COVID-19 guidelines during the blood drive. Donors can save time using the RapidPass registration process. COVID-19 Closure Updates

On June 15, 2021, Governor Cuomo announced that COVID-19 restrictions are lifted immediately as 70 percent of New Yorkers aged 18 or older have received the first dose of their COVID-19 vaccination series. The State's health guidance and New York Forward industry specific guidelines—including social gathering limits, capacity restrictions, social distancing, cleaning and disinfection, health screening, and contact information for tracing—are now optional for retail, food services, offices, gyms and fitness centers, amusement and family entertainment, hair salons, barber shops and personal care services, among other commercial settings.

Unvaccinated individuals continue to be responsible for wearing masks, in accordance with federal CDC guidance. Consistent with the State's implementation of the recent CDC guidance, masks are still required for unvaccinated individuals.
