# HELP THE BEAR MOVE ALONG – TAKE DOWN YOUR BIRD FEEDERS

We've still got a young bear wandering in Pittsford that needs our help to ensure he or she moves along to a safe home! The bear was spotted earlier this week in south Pittsford near West Bloomfield road. We're told the bear is not likely to leave if it keeps finding its current favorite snack – seed and other edibles in bird feeders. If you live in the south of Pittsford in areas surrounding Barker Road, W. Bloomfield Road, Mendon Road, and Mendon Center Road, please consider removing your bird

feeders for the next few days.

The bear seems to be heading south toward less populated areas (and toward a good home) but keeps getting turned back, most likely to forage from feeders. A bear can smell food from over a mile away and will walk to get it! It's also worth noting that the longer a bear stays around people, the more it associates food with humans – which often results in deadly consequences for the bear.

Let's help this young bear get back on track – please remove your bird feeders if the bear is in your area.



## **COVID-19 Closure Updates**

On June 15, 2021, Governor Cuomo announced that COVID-19 restrictions are lifted immediately as 70 percent of New Yorkers aged 18 or older have received the first dose of their COVID-19 vaccination series. The State's health guidance and New York Forward industry specific guidelines—including social gathering limits, capacity restrictions, social distancing, cleaning and disinfection, health screening, and contact information for tracing—are now optional for retail, food services, offices, gyms and fitness centers, amusement and family entertainment, hair salons, barber shops and personal care services, among other commercial settings.

Unvaccinated individuals continue to be responsible for wearing masks, in accordance with federal CDC guidance. Consistent with the State's implementation of the recent CDC guidance, masks are still required for unvaccinated individuals.
