# TOWN'S PESTICIDE POLICY: MINIMIZING PESTICIDE USE

The Town's Pesticide Policy is our Integrated Pest Management program. Developed in cooperation with Cornell University and New York State Integrated Pest Management and reviewed periodically with them, it provides the Town with sustainable grounds maintenance on the 2,400 acres of land we maintain.

We follow the science.

Pittsford's Parks Department works closely

with Cornell and NYS Integrated Pest Management to continually reduce even further the minimal amount of non-organic chemicals and substances necessary for grounds the Town maintains.

On the 2,400 acres of land the Town of Pittsford maintains, we're now at the point where the Town and its contractors together use less synthetic pesticides and herbicides each year than are used on just two – *two* – houses on half-acre lots that use a lawn service. Our staff only uses synthetics when it's absolutely necessary for public safety in using Town fields, and they're constantly trained in their proper and safe use.

The Head of our Parks operations, Jessica Neal, made a public report on the most recent major update of our Pesticide Policy, the Integrated Pest Management program, together with representatives from Cornell and NYS Integrated Pest Management. *YOU can help.* The Town Administration's s commitment to reducing use of toxic chemicals throughout Pittsford is active on many fronts: not just in the Town's own maintenance practices, but also in our encouraging native plantings and in our *Toxic-Free Lawn Challenge*.

Take the challenge! If you have a lawn service, carefully assess and discuss your needs with your service provider. This can help you avoid unnecessary pesticide treatments on your property. For example, lawn grubs don't feed in the spring, so any spring

treatment for grubs is unnecessary and wastes your money.

We encourage residents to follow the Town's practice of using pesticides responsibly and only when strictly necessary.

The recall was posted August 4, 2021. The recalled dehumidifiers can overheat and catch fire, posing fire and burn hazards. ## **COVID-19 Closure Updates**

On June 15, 2021, Governor Cuomo announced that COVID-19 restrictions are lifted immediately as 70 percent of New Yorkers aged 18 or older have received the first dose of their COVID-19 vaccination series. The State's health guidance and New York Forward industry specific guidelines—including social gathering limits, capacity restrictions, social distancing, cleaning and disinfection, health screening, and contact information for tracing—are now optional for retail, food services, offices, gyms and fitness centers, amusement and family entertainment, hair salons, barber shops and personal care services, among other commercial settings.

On August 2, 2021, Monroe County was designated as a County with a "substantial" COVID infection. Consequently, the CDC now recommends that people, regardless of vaccination status, wear a mask indoors. This is a recommendation, not a mandate. The guidelines are unclear at this point, as is the situation. Neither the State, the County or the Town has imposed a mask *requirement* at this stage.

Unvaccinated individuals continue to be responsible for wearing masks, in accordance with federal CDC guidance. Consistent with the State's implementation of the recent CDC guidance, masks are still required for unvaccinated individuals.
