
CONCERT FOR KIDS TONIGHT WITH MR. LOOPS

TAX INFORMATION

Town of Pittsford residents will receive their 2021-2022 school tax bills in the mail by or after September 1, 2021. If your bill does not arrive by Monday, September 6, please call the tax office at 585-248-6215. Legally, we cannot accept payment until September 1. First installments are due by Wednesday, 9/15. Full payments



will be accepted through Friday, 10/1. Please include your stub and phone number with your payment. Consistent with our practice since the onset of the pandemic, the Town will continue to encourage payments by mail or by secure mail slots which are located at both the front and back of the Pittsford Town Hall, 11 South Main Street. Full payments may also be made online via a link from the Town's website to the Monroe County website, using Visa and MasterCard only; there will be a 3% fee to use this online payment service. On-time first and full payments only may also be paid at Canandaigua National Bank, 18 State Street, in the Pittsford Village.

Payment for First installments AFTER SEPTEMBER 15 will only be accepted from September 16 - September 20, with 1% interest. These payments can be mailed or placed in the secure mail slots located at both the front and back of the Pittsford Town Hall, 11 South Main Street. The additional 1% must be calculated on the entire amount of the 1st installment, if you need assistance in that calculation, please contact the tax office directly at 585-248-6215 for the correct amount due.

Please Note: We strongly discourage paying your tax bill via Electronic Checking/Online bill pay system. If paying your bill with an online bill pay system, please be aware that your bank still mails us a paper check without a USPS postmark and it may take as long as two weeks to reach our office. Therefore, we cannot consider your payment received until we physically receive the payment in our office. We do not recommend sending payment in this manner.



COVID-19 Closure Updates

On June 15, 2021, Governor Cuomo announced that COVID-19 restrictions are lifted immediately as 70 percent of New Yorkers aged 18 or older have received the first dose of their COVID-19 vaccination series. The State's health guidance and New York Forward industry specific guidelines—including social gathering limits, capacity restrictions, social distancing, cleaning and disinfection, health screening, and contact information for tracing—are now optional for retail, food services, offices, gyms and fitness centers, amusement and family entertainment, hair salons, barber shops and personal care services, among other commercial settings.

On August 2, 2021, Monroe County was designated as a County with a "substantial" COVID infection. Consequently, the CDC now recommends that people, regardless of vaccination status, wear a mask indoors. This is a recommendation, not a mandate. The guidelines are unclear at this point, as is the situation. Neither the State, the County or the Town has imposed a mask *requirement* at this stage. pp

Unvaccinated individuals continue to be responsible for wearing masks, in accordance with federal CDC guidance. Consistent with the State's implementation of the recent CDC guidance, masks are still required for unvaccinated individuals.
