#### **COPPER BEECH TREE SAPLINGS AVAILABLE**

Our Copper Beech tree saplings, cloned from the majestic original Copper Beech at our park in the Village, are ready for planting! We have a limited number of saplings available for Pittsford residents – if you are interested in obtaining one, please see the information below.



- Copper beeches grow fairly quickly, and will eventually grow to be 60-80' high and 40-60' wide, perhaps even larger in some cases.
- Because they get so large, take care to plant them away from houses and other trees. They need plenty of room to grow!
- They prefer full sunlight, but can tolerate part-sunlight. They do not like full shade.
- Plant in well-drained soil. Poorly drained or compacted soil can lead to fungal disease.
- After planting, put a 3" thick ring of mulch around the tree, but be careful to not mulch above the base of the tree (no mulch volcanos).
- Water the soil around the beech tree to a depth of 8-10" once per week if no rainfall occurs, and increase to 2-3 times a week during the summer to prevent the soil from drying out.
- Be careful not to over-water, however. Soggy soil will harm the tree.

# TOWN OFFICES & COMMUNITY CENTER CLOSED MONDAY FOR JUNETEENTH HOLIDAY

Town offices and the Spiegel Pittsford Community Center will be closed this Monday, June 20 in observance of the State and Federal Juneteenth holiday, which commemorates the end to slavery and celebrates Black and African American freedom and achievements. The Pittsford Community Library will be open regular hours.

Juneteenth commemorates June 19, 1865, when the news of emancipation came to Texas more than two years after President Abraham Lincoln's Emancipation Proclamation went into effect on January 1, 1863. African Americans across the state were made aware of their right to freedom on this day when Major General Gordon Granger arrived in Galveston with federal troops to read General Order No. 3 announcing the end of the Civil War and that all those enslaved were now free, as well as to maintain a presence in Texas for the purpose of enforcing emancipation among slave-owners throughout the state.

### **COVID-19 Access Updates**

3/2/22 Update: the Statewide mask mandate for schools expired 3/1, mask use is now optional in Pittsford School District schools; for more information, visit www.pittsfordschools.org/COVID-19INFORMATION. The mandate remains in place for health care facilities, transportation and other related entities.

2/10/22 Update: the Statewide mask mandate has has expired for indoor public spaces including grocery stores, shops and offices. The mandate remains for other settings such as health care facilities and schools.

1/31/22 Update: the Governor's mask mandate extended to February 10, 2022. 12/13/21 Update: By order of NYS Governor Kathy Hochul, until January 15, 2022 the Town must require all persons entering Town buildings to be masked, regardless of vaccination status. This applies to all Town indoor facilities, including Town Hall, the Spiegel Pittsford Community Center, the Pittsford Community Library, Town Court and the Highway Department, Sewer Department and Parks Department offices.

On June 15, 2021, Governor Cuomo announced that COVID-19 restrictions are lifted immediately as 70 percent of New Yorkers aged 18 or older have received the first dose of their COVID-19 vaccination series. The State's health guidance and New York Forward industry specific guidelines—including social gathering limits, capacity restrictions, social distancing, cleaning and disinfection, health screening, and contact information for tracing—are now optional for retail, food services, offices, gyms and fitness centers, amusement and family entertainment, hair salons, barber shops and personal care services, among other commercial settings.

On August 2, 2021, Monroe County was designated as a County with a "substantial" COVID infection. Consequently, the CDC now recommends that people, regardless of vaccination status, wear a mask indoors. This is a recommendation, not a mandate. The guidelines are unclear at this point, as is the situation. Neither the State, the County or the Town has imposed a mask *requirement* at this stage.

Unvaccinated individuals continue to be responsible for wearing masks, in accordance with federal CDC guidance. Consistent with the State's implementation of the recent CDC guidance, masks are still required for unvaccinated individuals.
