BIKE RODEO BIKE SAFETY PROGRAM AT COMMUNITY CENTER IS THIS SATURDAY, 5/20

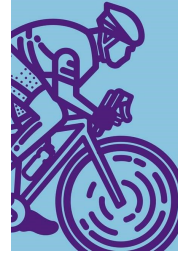
Learn safety tips from a Traffic Safety Specialist and practice on obstacle course!

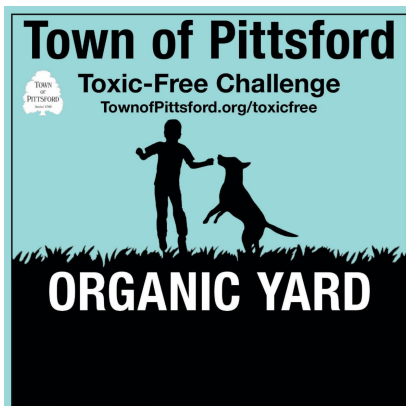

The Town of Pittsford has an American Sign Language interpreter available at every Pittsford Town Board meeting, to interpret for those who need this service. Requests can be made in advance or can be emailed through the first ten minutes of the meeting.
