

EARLY SPRING CLEAN UP (APRIL)

Beginning when the weather breaks
and continuing through April 30

Loose piles of leaves, thatch, brush, branches and yard debris will be collected. **Please note crews will pick up both loose debris and/or containerized debris during this time.**

REGULAR COLLECTION (MAY - OCTOBER)

Loose Brush and Branches: May 3 - Oct 15
Bagged / Containerized: May 3 - Dec 9

- Please use paper bags or reusable containers. Composting sites do not accept plastic bags.
- **Grass clippings, weeds and smaller yard debris must be placed in a container.**
- Weight must not exceed 50 pounds per container.
- Cuttings must be less than 3 feet in length and tied in bundles.
- Brush and branches may be put in loose piles. They must be less than 8 feet in length and less than 8 inches in diameter.

GENERAL GUIDELINES

- There will be no collection on Memorial Day and Labor Day. Schedules will shift by one day following the holiday.
- Place yard debris behind the curb or gutter to avoid blocking drainage pathways or impeding traffic flow in your neighborhood.
- Material for pickup must be out by 6AM on your scheduled collection day.
- If you live on a private drive, take materials to the nearest public street.
- We cannot collect stumps, rocks, stones, metal, lumber, plastics, glass, fencing or waste materials.
- Our schedule may vary slightly due to weather conditions and volume of debris. We appreciate your patience.
- Material generated by landscape professionals must be removed as part of their service. This material may be taken to Pittsford's Highway Department, 60 Golf Avenue, weekdays from 7AM to 4PM.



LEAF COLLECTION (OCTOBER 18 TO DECEMBER 11)

Our crews will be in your neighborhood approximately every two weeks to collect loose leaf piles. During this time, crews will continue to pick up yard debris every week if it is placed in a bag/container and separated from your leaf piles. It is important to keep leaves and yard debris separate, as yard debris can damage our leaf vacuum. Please note that loose brush will not be picked up during this time.

FREE Mulch

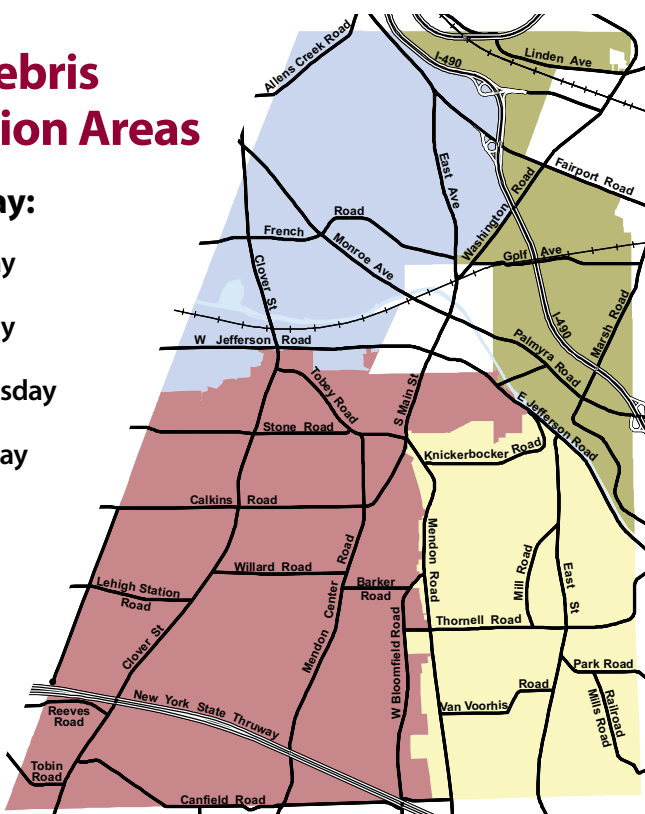
Wood and leaf mulch generated by the Town's yard debris recycling program are available FREE of charge to residents who visit the East Street storage site adjacent to the Little League fields.
