- e. The Green Committee has reported its considerations to the Town Board.

4. School District Update:

- a. The Budget Vote is one week from tomorrow.
- b. At the first Community Budget Seminar no one showed up. There is another one scheduled for this week.

5. The Town and School District are working on a new initiative – the Pittsford Youth Court. A brief discussion ensued on this topic.

6. A discussion ensued about a communication plan for informing the community about the recent designation for Pittsford as one of the "Best 100 Places to Live" Bill will provide the Village/School District with logo. Having cost shared banners around town was suggested.

7. Mary Alice said she will contact Peggy Lyons to develop a quality community publication.

8. It was noted that an evacuation drill will take place at Calkins Road Middle School shortly.

9. A brief discussion took place with regard to the possibility of a level 3 sex offender moving into Pittsford , the swine flu issue, the recent Canandaigua school shooting incident and the missing Chili student.
