REVIEW OF JUNE 3, 2010 WORKSHOP NOTES

June 3, 2010: The group approved these notes and praised Linda Dillon for a job well done.

March 22, 2010: The group unanimously approved these notes.

REVIEW OF COLLABORATIVE BROCHURE

The group reviewed each page of the draft brochure *Pittsford – A Community of Planned Success*. Following discussion, final revisions were made to the wording of some paragraphs and information was added regarding shopping and dining. Bill recorded all changes and will deliver them to Kate Munzinger and Nancy Wayman. It was noted that legal counsel may be needed to determine the legalities surrounding rights to photos used in the brochure.

The group discussed ways to utilize the publication, set a positive tone, and make the public aware of the accomplishment. The Board reviewed the list of suggested ways to distribute the brochure that was developed at the June workshop meeting. The group decided that for the next meeting they would obtain a cost proposal for printing options.

REPORTS

Village

Bob reported that a Town/Village draft traffic study for the Monroe Avenue Corridor has been completed by SRF Associates.

He further reported that the Village has received a \$99,000 grant to build a pavilion on the former Newcomb Oil gas dock.

Town

Bill reported that the Town is in the process of forming a consortium with twelve other communities. The consortium would provide a health care program for employees.

Record crowds attended the 2010 Positively Pittsford event.

Bill told the group that the County will be paving portions of Stone Road. A resident has offered to build a multi-use trail along the south side of the road.

The Town will share grant funding with the Village to build new docks on the south side of the canal. The construction will take place after the World Canal Conference.

School District

Mary Alice said that 2010 graduation went well.

Representatives from the F.L.I.P. group attended a School Board Meeting and presented rough plans for field lighting in four different locations. The School Board charged Mary Alice with forming a school directed committee to move forward on options and costs for field lights. She will keep the Leadership Committee apprised.

The process for the formation of regional schools was discussed as an informational item.

Other Items:

The group discussed the positives of having Nazareth College and St. John Fisher College as part of the Pittsford community. Members suggested inviting college representatives to a future Leadership Meeting, perhaps when the new brochure is launched.
