### ANIMAL CONTROL CORNER

Did you know that when your dog barks habitually it is violating a town code? The town code forbids any dog owner to permit their dog to engage in habitual loud howling or barking. To prevent habitual barking, dog owners should bring their dog inside or correct them when they hear barking. Training is another option that owners can use, whether it is obedience training or using a bark collar. One of the best solutions, however, is to make sure that your dog is properly

exercised. Letting your dog out in the back yard is not proper exercise. Dogs should be walked regularly. A happy dog is one that is well exercised!
