KEEP YOUR VEHICLE SAFE FROM THEFT

Did you know that most car "break-ins" happen to vehicles which are left unlocked? Be sure to lock your doors whenever your car is unattended – whether parking in your driveway, on the street or in a parking lot. Thieves also tend to select vehicles that have valuables in plain sight. Very few break-ins are "random." The thieves usually see something out in the open or hints of possible hidden valuables (such as GPS holders or cell phone cords). So be safe – be sure to remove (or at least remove from sight) valuables such as GPS systems, cell phones, etc. Even a pile of change or a stack of mail visible through your window is enough to make a thief notice your car, day or night. Take the extra time to be extra safe!
