TAX INFORMATION | REMINDER

Residents of the Pittsford Central School District will receive their 2011-2012 tax bills in the mail soon. If your bill has not arrived by Friday, September 9, please call the tax office at 248-6215. First installments are due by Thursday, 9/15. Payment will be accepted in full through Saturday, 10/1. The Town Clerk will extend office hours, for tax payments only, from 8AM to 6PM on Thursday, 9/15 and Friday, 9/30. For residents paying their bills at Town Hall, there will be 10 minute parking available in the parking lot behind the building on these two days. Taxes also may be paid at Canandaigua National Bank, 18 State Street, or online via the Town's website.
