PUBLIC HEARING ON RN ZONING LEGISLATION CHANGE | WEDNESDAY, 12/7

The Pittsford Town Board will hold a public hearing on Wednesday, December 7 at 7PM in the Pittsford Sutherland High School auditorium to discuss an amendment to the pending Residential Neighborhood (RN) Zoning legislation which was proposed at the 11/15 Town Board meeting. The legislation relates to the creation of a new Residential Zoning District, Residential Design Standards and Guidelines, and a revised proposal for creation of a new combined Design Review and Historic Preservation Board.
