It's not too early to plan for your spring planting projects and you can help conservation efforts in our area while you do! The [Monroe County Soil and Water \(MCSW\) Conservation District's](#) annual Tree, Shrub, and Plant program is currently underway and offers a wide variety of evergreens, deciduous trees, shrubs, plant variety conservation packs, and even enhancement items like bluebird nesting boxes and bat roosting boxes!

Proceeds from the annual sale will benefit the MCSW Conservation District's education and preservation programs. Prices range from \$11 for a bundle of 10 seedling plants to bundles of 100 plants for an average of \$84.

Orders are due by 3/18 and will be ready for pick up on April 19 & 20 at the [ecopark](#) facilities (10 Avion Drive, Rochester 14624).
