# RECYCLING AN OLD ENERGY-WASTING REFRIGERATOR OR FREEZER BY 8/31 COULD WIN YOU A PRIZE

NYSEG and RG&E customers who recycle a working second refrigerator or freezer can win a \$250 prepaid debit card when they schedule a free home pick up now through August 31 to recycle energywasting refrigerators or freezers courtesy of the NYSEG/RG&E refrigerator/freezer recycling program. All participants will receive a \$30 incentive and stand to save up to \$150 a year by unplugging these energy-wasting appliances. Second refrigerators or freezers kept for extra cold storage in garages or basements are usually older models, which many people don't realize can use as much as three times more electricity to run than newer models built to higher energy efficiency standards. Refrigerators and freezers to be recycled must be in working order and have an inside volume of between 10 and 30 cubic feet. The recycling program also ensures proper disposal of old refrigerators and freezers, which can leak mercury and other toxins into the environment when discarded improperly.
