

PEDDLER AND SOLICITORS PERMITS

The suspension of permits previously instituted due to the Coronavirus has been lifted and Peddlers and Solicitors are being permitted to resume their business, following the necessary guidelines as outlined by the State of New York. If you do not want solicitation to occur at your door, you can post a “No Solicitation” sign on your property (on the door, a window or in your yard), and the solicitor must adhere to the sign or their permit can be revoked.

2021 Solicitors Permits

*Not-for-Profits – are not required to obtain a Permit nor notify the Town. However, if they do notify the Town, they are listed below. They may be soliciting or going door-to-door for their organization and/or governmental agency’s work. They are required to abide by the Pittsford Town Code, Chapter 112 – Peddlers and Solicitors.

The following list of solicitors or not-for-profits should not be construed as an endorsement of any products or organizations by the Town of Pittsford. If you have a peddler or solicitor and they do not appear on this list or you are not certain that they are a not-for-profit, please call the Town Clerk’s office at 585-248-6214.
