### **Rick Taylor, Chairman:**

- Rick reviewed the Parks & Rec. Board: our purpose and capabilities, for the guests at the meeting.

### **Dept. of Public Works Update:**

**Commissioner of Public Works:** Paul Schenkel reported on the following:

- The new subdivisions and their trails.
- This past year the Parks Dept. has worked on:
  - a. Expanding the community garden
  - b. Integrated pest management plan
  - c. Future pollinated gardens, fields and working with neighborhoods for these gardens.
  - d. Removing dead ash trees.
- The town dog park has been a huge success, with a small issue regarding entry to the park. Rick questioned the need for controlled entry. It is a matter of dog registrations/vaccinations, and a liability issue.
- Paul discussed the details on installing the handicap accessible kayak/canoe dock on the canal.
- Paul reviewed the sidewalk projects, trail improvements, parking lots and sport courts resurfacing, the new Copper Beech project and the boat docking issues at the Port of Pittsford Park.

**Comments:** The following topics were discussed by the board members:

- Questions on the location of some new sidewalks in the town.
- The regulations of boat docking at the Port.
