

The <u>Veterans Outreach Center</u> provides to veterans employment assistance and job training, health and wellness programs, veteran and family support programs, legal counseling, and a residential program, among other services. **Specific needs** for the Veteran's Outreach Center include winter hats and gloves, dog and cat food (dry and wet), full-sized shampoo and toothpaste, and canned fruits, vegetables, soups and beans, rice and pasta; find a complete list of needs here.

The <u>Nazareth College Oak Tree Food Pantry</u> connects Nazareth's students, staff and faculty to outside resources based on a number of needs including housing, food, community centers and transportation. **Specific needs** for the Oak Tree Food Pantry include **items that can be easily prepared by students**.

A variety of canned and other packaged goods and personal items are needed for the Pittsford Food Cupboard (see <u>list of Pittsford Food Cupboard needs</u>) including plain oatmeal, hot cocoa, coffee, canned meats and fish, dry cat and dog food, pizza sauce, and 100% juice, as well as body wash and conditioner; reusable grocery bags also are needed. The Pittsford Food Cupboard also needs baking items for clients for the holidays such as flour, sugar, sprinkles, food coloring, cookie mix, etc. Established in 1998, the PFC serves needs in Pittsford, Mendon, Honeoye Falls, Brighton, East Rochester and some areas in the City of Rochester. It provides food supplies and other essential goods to over 4,000 households, totaling more than 9,400 people.

The Pittsford Food Cupboard, Nazareth College Oak Tree Food Pantry and the Veterans Outreach Center are among the many organizations that benefit from Pittsford Rotary's mission of service to our community and beyond. Please help our Rotarians help those in need if you can!

COVID-19 Access Updates

3/2/22 Update: the Statewide mask mandate for schools expired 3/1, mask use is now optional in Pittsford School District schools; for more information, visit www.pittsfordschools.org/COVID-19INFORMATION. The mandate remains in place for health care facilities, transportation and other related entities.

2/10/22 Update: the Statewide mask mandate has has expired for indoor public spaces including grocery stores, shops and offices. The mandate remains for other settings such as health care facilities and schools.

1/31/22 Update: the Governor's mask mandate extended to February 10, 2022. 12/13/21 Update: By order of NYS Governor Kathy Hochul, until January 15, 2022 the Town must require all persons entering Town buildings to be masked, regardless of vaccination status. This applies to all Town indoor facilities, including Town Hall, the Spiegel Pittsford Community Center, the Pittsford Community Library, Town Court and the Highway Department, Sewer Department and Parks Department offices.

On June 15, 2021, Governor Cuomo announced that COVID-19 restrictions are lifted immediately as 70 percent of New Yorkers aged 18 or older have received the first dose of their COVID-19 vaccination series. The State's health guidance and New York Forward industry specific guidelines—including social gathering limits, capacity restrictions, social distancing, cleaning and disinfection, health screening, and contact information for tracing—are now optional for retail, food services, offices, gyms and fitness centers, amusement and family entertainment, hair salons, barber shops and personal care services, among other commercial settings.

On August 2, 2021, Monroe County was designated as a County with a "substantial" COVID infection. Consequently, the CDC now recommends that people, regardless of vaccination status, wear a mask indoors. This is a recommendation, not a mandate. The guidelines are unclear at this point, as is the situation. Neither the

State, the County or the Town has imposed a mask *requirement* at this stage.

Unvaccinated individuals continue to be responsible for wearing masks, in accordance with federal CDC guidance. Consistent with the State's implementation of the recent CDC guidance, masks are still required for unvaccinated individuals.
