2023 TOWN & COUNTY PROPERTY TAX INFORMATION

Reminder for those interested in prepayment: the Tax Office will be closing at 1:00pm on Friday, December 30. Please follow directions outlined below.



Town of Pittsford property owners whose taxes are not in escrow will receive their 2023 Town

and County tax bills in the mail after January 1, 2023. Property tax bills also may be obtained through the Monroe County Real Property Portal on or after December 31, 2022. Click the following link for <u>step-by-step directions on how to access your tax bill information online</u>.

Important Tax Collection Dates:

January 1 – First day of tax collection. Legally, we cannot accept any payments prior.
February 10 – Full payment or first installment is due.
February 28 – Second installment is due.
March 31 – Third installment is due.

April 30 – Fourth installment is due.

If you are considering prepayment of your 2023 Town and County taxes, we recommend consulting with your accountant to determine if prepayment would be beneficial to you under the federal and state tax laws in effect. Please notify the tax office via email at <u>townclerk@townofpittsford.org</u> or by phone at 585-248-6215 if you will be mailing in a prepayment with a U.S. postmark of December 31, 2022; doing so will ensure you are correctly receipted for your payment. PYS EFFECTIVE AND POSITIVE PARENTING PROGRAM

Pittsford Youth Services is offering a free parenting group on Saturday mornings for six consecutive sessions from 9:00 – 10:00am starting on January 7, 2023 and running through February 11, 2023. The group will learn about the *1-2-3 Magic* parenting program from Dr. Thomas Phelan. *1-2-3 Magic* is an effective, positive parenting program that divides parenting responsibilities into three parts: controlling negative behavior, encouraging good behavior and strengthening the child-parent relationship.



PYS YOUTH SOCIAL SKILLS GROUP PROGRAM FOR 6th GRADERS

Pittsford Youth Services is offering a 6th grade social skills group for six consecutive sessions on Saturday mornings from 10:15-11:15 starting on January 7, 2023 and running through February 11, 2023. The goal of the group is to teach social emotional skills to help children cope with every day triggers and stressors, and to reinforce resilience and positive behavior. The focus will be on self awareness, establishing and maintaining friendships, peer pressure and bullying, emotional regulation and frustration tolerance. The program will include conversations utilizing a variety of activities, in addition to art and music therapy.

Please note: if you try to log in too early (before the meeting feed is live) you will see an error message; refresh your screen just prior to or at 6:00pm when the board meeting starts and you will be able to view the meeting. COVID-19 Access Updates

3/2/22 Update: the Statewide mask mandate for schools expired 3/1, mask use is now optional in Pittsford School District schools; for more information, visit

www.pittsfordschools.org/COVID-19INFORMATION. The mandate remains in place for health care facilities, transportation and other related entities.

2/10/22 Update: the Statewide mask mandate has has expired for indoor public spaces including grocery stores, shops and offices. The mandate remains for other settings such as health care facilities and schools.

1/31/22 Update: the Governor's mask mandate extended to February 10, 2022. 12/13/21 Update: By order of NYS Governor Kathy Hochul, until January 15, 2022 the

Town must require all persons entering Town buildings to be masked, regardless of vaccination status. This applies to all Town indoor facilities, including Town Hall, the Spiegel Pittsford Community Center, the Pittsford Community Library, Town Court and the Highway Department, Sewer Department and Parks Department offices.

On June 15, 2021, Governor Cuomo announced that COVID-19 restrictions are lifted immediately as 70 percent of New Yorkers aged 18 or older have received the first dose of their COVID-19 vaccination series. The State's health guidance and New York Forward industry specific guidelines—including social gathering limits, capacity restrictions, social distancing, cleaning and disinfection, health screening, and contact information for tracing—are now optional for retail, food services, offices, gyms and fitness centers, amusement and family entertainment, hair salons, barber shops and personal care services, among other commercial settings.

On August 2, 2021, Monroe County was designated as a County with a "substantial" COVID infection. Consequently, the CDC now recommends that people, regardless of vaccination status, wear a mask indoors. This is a recommendation, not a mandate. The guidelines are unclear at this point, as is the situation. Neither the State, the County or the Town has imposed a mask *requirement* at this stage.

Unvaccinated individuals continue to be responsible for wearing masks, in accordance with federal CDC guidance. Consistent with the State's implementation of the recent CDC guidance, masks are still required for unvaccinated individuals.
