development.


TOWN'S PGA FAMILY NIGHT AND CONCERT IS MAY 17!

The Rotary Club of Pittsford will hold its 12th annual "Bike Drop" on Saturday, May 6 from 9:00am - 2:00pm at Pittsford Mendon High School (472 Mendon Road, Pittsford). Bicycles or bike parts in any condition will be accepted for donation. The bicycles and bike parts will be collected by Pittsford Rotary and donated to R Community Bikes, Inc., a Rochester-based charitable organization that repairs and distributes bicycles free of charge to Rochester's needy children

and adults. For those in need, bikes are very frequently the most affordable means of transportation to jobs, schools, churches, rehabilitation and training programs, and meals at local social service agencies.

ROTARY FOOD DRIVE MOVES TO MENDON HIGH SCHOOL FOR MAY ONLY

- Drive to be held May 6 will coincide with Rotary Bike Drop Collection
- Food donations will go to Pittsford Food Cupboard and the Community Food Cupboard of Rochester



The <u>Rotary Club of Pittsford</u>, in collaboration with the Town of Pittsford, is holding its May 6 drive-through canned and packaged food and donations drive **at Mendon High School (this month only)**, to coincide with the Rotary Bike Drop collection. Food and supplies donated will benefit the <u>Pittsford Food Cupboard</u> and the <u>Community Food Cupboard of Rochester</u>. The Food Drive will take place from 9:00am – 2:00pm at the Pittsford Mendon High School parking lot (472 Mendon Road). The Bike Drop also will take place from 9:00am – 2:00pm; see story above for Bike Drop details.

The <u>Community Food Cupboard of Rochester</u> is a non-profit food cupboard dedicated to feeding hungry families and home-bound senior citizens in Northeast Rochester and Irondequoit. In addition to access by appointment, the Community Food Cupboard of Rochester provides emergency food assistance for those with an immediate need, and a monthly delivery service for medically referred individuals.

Specific items needed for the May 6 food drive include cleaning supplies, reusable grocery bags, any canned tomato products (diced, stewed, whole, pureed, crushed), plain oatmeal, rice sides, boxed white pasta (no whole grain, please), 100% juice, dry cat and dog food, beets, coconut milk, collard greens, spinach, olives, mushrooms, pizza sauce, jalapenos, and green chiles. The cupboard has no more room for corn or any kind of canned beans. The Pittsford Food Cupboard has no more room for corn or any kind of canned beans.

Rotarians, students from the Pittsford Interact Club and Town staff will be collecting items rain, snow or shine.
