
The parade begins at 10:00am, stepping off from Pittsford Sutherland High School and continuing down Jefferson Road to Main Street, then on to the Pittsford Cemetery (Washington Road) and culminating in a moving Remembrance Ceremony. Following

the ceremony, the Rayson-Miller American Legion Post #899 will host a reception at the Legion Post headquarters (21 N. Main Street, in Village Hall). STONE ROAD CLOSURE FOR COUNTY'S **CULVERT WORK IS UNDER WAY**

The Monroe County Department of Transportation (DOT) closed part of Stone Road in Pittsford as of Monday, May 22 to complete Phase 1 of its culvert replacement project. The project will be done in two phases and is expected to be completed by the end of September, 2023. Refer to the County DOT info

Phase 1 is under way and involves work on Stone Road at the culvert located between Stoney Clover Lane and Wexford Glen. The tentative completion is July, 2023. Once this work is completed, Phase 2 is expected to begin in July, 2023 and will involve work on Stone Road at the culvert between Chelsea Park/Merryhill Lane and Chatham Woods.

To complete the work for each phase, Stone Road will be fully closed at the respective culvert locations while work is being done. Through-traffic will be detoured during each phase using two separate detours as shown on the map found here. Message boards and detour signage also will be placed in the area.


During both closures, access to local side streets and properties will be maintained; traffic will be prohibited from driving across the actual culvert being worked on. NATIONAL POPPY DAY IS THIS FRIDAY, 5/26 – REMEMBER THE FALLEN

National Poppy Day is this Friday, May 26. Do you have a Remembrance Poppy to wear in honor of the servicemen and women who lost their lives during war-time service? Members of Rayson-Miller American Legion Post #899 are currently offering them — along with flag stars and stick flags — at various locations around Town, including the Pittsford Dairy and Powers Farm Market. Funds raised from the annual poppy sale go directly to benefit veterans, many of whom who are disabled, homeless or in severe financial crisis due to circumstances beyond their control. Donations help veterans via the Canandaigua VA Volunteer Homeless Program, Patriot Guard Riders New York's Help on the Homefront, and Honor Flight Rochester, which ensures all veterans may see our national veterans memorials. All of the funds raised – 100% – are used for these services; no funds are kept by the Rayson-Miller post.



HISTORIC PITTSFORD TRIVIA NIGHT AT VIA GIRASOLE THIS TUESDAY, 5/30



Please note: if you try to log in too early (before the meeting feed is live) you will see an error message; refresh your screen just prior to or at 6:00pm when the board meeting starts and you will be able to view the meeting. As always, ASL interpretation is provided for every Town Board meeting.
