## NEW HOURS FOR TOWN HALL BEGIN THIS MONDAY, JUNE 5

Town Hall will be open 8:00am – 4:00pm, Monday – Friday

Over time, residents and contractors have asked for earlier business hours at Town Hall. This would enable people to take care of Town Hall business before starting their own work day. In addition, there has been a noticeable decrease of people coming in to transact business in the late afternoon.





After surveying Town Hall staff, we're changing

our office hours. Beginning this Monday, June 5, Town Hall business hours will run from 8:00am to 4:00pm. In addition to conforming more closely to the public demand, we believe the changed afternoon hours will help avoid the serious congestion – and safety risks – in the lot behind Town Hall when there's a high level of incoming traffic and activity there at 5:00pm every day.

The change in hours affects Town Hall offices only.

As always, residents who cannot make it to Town Hall during business hours can submit items for staff through the mail slots at the front and back doors to the building.

## STONE ROAD CLOSURE FOR COUNTY'S CULVERT WORK IS UNDER WAY

The Monroe County Department of Transportation (DOT) has closed part of Stone Road in Pittsford to complete Phase 1 of its culvert replacement project. The project will be done in two phases and is expected to be completed by the end of September, 2023. Refer to the County DOT info sheet and map of the detour routes found here.



**Phase 1 is under way** and involves work on Stone Road at the culvert located between Stoney Clover Lane and Wexford Glen. The tentative completion is July, 2023. Once this work is completed, Phase 2 is expected to begin in July, 2023 and will involve work on Stone Road at the culvert between Chelsea Park/Merryhill Lane and Chatham Woods.

To complete the work for each phase, **Stone Road will be fully closed at the respective culvert locations while work is being done**. Through-traffic will be detoured during

each phase using <u>two separate detours as shown on the map found here</u>. Message boards and detour signage also will be placed in the area.

**During both closures, access to local side streets and properties will be maintained**; traffic will be prohibited from driving across the actual culvert being worked on. 
