FOOD SCRAPS RECYCLING PROGRAM OPEN TO PITTSFORD HOUSEHOLDS

The Town of Pittsford is partnering with Monroe County to offer a Food Scraps Recycling pilot program to 500 Pittsford households. Recycling food scraps keeps them out of the landfill. This program will turn food scraps into renewable energy!

Participating Pittsford residents will separate and collect their household's food scraps and organic kitchen waste and drop it off at the Town's collection site at the Town Dog Park. The scraps will be picked up as part of the County's pilot program and will be processed in an anaerobic digester – an air-tight chamber that uses bacteria to "digest" (break down) the organic matter, producing natural gas that can be used to generate electricity. The electricity produced will be used by the processor and sold back to the grid.

Pittsford participants will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis – registration will take place via the Town website beginning August 9, 2023 and the program will begin September 18. Participants will be provided with lidded and labeled buckets to contain

CANAL TRAIL MAINTENANCE UNDERWAY BY NYS CANAL CORP

The Town was advised last week that the NYS Canal Corporation will be conducting

maintenance work along the Erie Canalway Trail between Pittsford and Macedon; it began this past Monday, July 24. The work includes removing low hanging branches

from the overhead tree canopy and removing overgrowth that has increased due to the recent wet weather. We're told it will be routine maintenance that aims to improve accessibility and safety along the trail and is not part of their Earthen Embankment Integrity program. Workers will be in the area operating construction equipment. Some short-term closures (15-30 minutes) of the trail are expected. Trail users should exercise caution near the identified work zones. The work is expected to be completed over the next 4-6 weeks.




behind the Spiegel Pittsford Community Center.




