NEW YEAR'S HOURS FOR TOWN FACILITIES

In observance of the New Year's holiday Town Hall will close at 1:00pm on Friday, 12/29 and all Town offices (including Town Hall, Town Court, and the Parks, Sewer, and Highway departments) will be closed on Monday, 1/1/24.

The Spiegel Pittsford Community Center will be closed on Sunday 12/31 and Monday, 1/1/24. They will resume regular hours on Tuesday, 1/2/24 (8:00am-9:00pm).



The Pittsford Community Library will be closed on Sunday, 12/31 and Monday, 1/1/24, and will resume regular hours (9:00am – 8:00pm) on Tuesday, 1/2/2024.

2024 TOWN & COUNTY PROPERTY TAX INFORMATION

Reminder: for those interested in pre-payment, the Tax Office will be closing at 1:00pm on Friday, December 29. Please follow directions outlined below.

Town of Pittsford property owners not in escrow will receive their 2024 Town & County tax bills in the mail

after January 1, 2024. Property tax bills may also be obtained through the Monroe County Real Property Portal on or after December 29, 2023. Click the link for <u>step-by-step directions</u> on how to access the information that way.

Important Tax Collection Dates:

January 1 – First day of tax collection. Legally, we cannot accept any payments prior.

February 10 – Full payment or first installment is due.

February 28 – Second installment is due.

March 31 – Third installment is due.

April 30 – Fourth installment is due.

If you are considering prepayment of your 2024 Town and County taxes, we recommend consulting with your accountant to determine if prepayment would be beneficial to you under the federal and state tax laws in effect. Please notify the tax office via email at townclerk@townofpittsford.org or by phone, 585-248-6215 if you will be mailing in a prepayment with a U.S. postmark of December 30, 2023, so that you are correctly receipted for your payment. Balance exercises help older adults gain confidence in their physical abilities, leading to active and fulfilling lives!

The winter months may make it less likely that some older adults can attend in-person exercise classes. This online class – available via Zoom – is a great option for those seeking a way to stay fit and healthy when it's cold and icy outside!



Pittsford Town Board meetings are being streamed live; the feed is accessible on any device. Town Board is typically held the first and third Tuesday of the month at 6:00pm at Town Hall. Please note: if you try to log in too early (before the meeting feed is live) you will see an error message; refresh your screen just prior to or at 6:00pm when the board meeting starts and you will be able to view the meeting. The Town of Pittsford has an American Sign Language interpreter available at every Pittsford Town Board meeting, to interpret for those who need this service. Those who can't attend a Town Board meeting in person but are planning to watch the meeting's live stream can confirm their need for the interpreter by emailing comments@townofpittsford.org. Requests can be made in advance or can be emailed through the first ten minutes of the meeting.
