Neighborhood Residential Zoning changes to be discussed; public participation needed

The Pittsford Town Board continues to conduct meetings to discuss the Town's Zoning Code Update! The next meeting is Wednesday, March 27 at 12:00pm in the lower-level meeting room at Pittsford Town Hall, 11 South Main Street. The Board will discuss potential residential zoning changes that could affect every neighborhood. Public participation is



important! The meeting is open to the public and will be live streamed.

Comments for the meeting may be submitted in advance via mail or email and may be submitted during the meeting either in person or via email. The meeting will be recorded and live streamed via the Town website. themed programs! Here are some upcoming programs for children and teens:





CELEBRATE PITTSFORD'S PIONEERING WOMEN – PROGRAM 3/27

Join Pittsford Town and Village Historian Vicki Masters Profitt on Wednesday, March 27 from 6:30 to 7:30pm as she introduces you to some of Pittsford's pioneering women of the past. Take a step back in time to hear about the perseverance of our female settlers! Discover the ladies who organized the Pittsford Political Equality Club in 1902. Learn about the doctors, pharmacists and businesswomen who called Pittsford home at the turn of the 20th century. This event is co-hosted by <u>Historic</u> <u>Pittsford</u> and is free and open to the public, no registration required.

GUIDED HIKE THIS SATURDAY THROUGH HISTORIC ERIE CANAL TRAILS

Pittsford Recreation's next guided trail hike is this Saturday, March 23. Get outdoors, meet others, and learn about the Erie Canal and some of its landmarks while hiking the <u>Historic Erie Canal Trails</u>. The fivemile hike begins at 8:30am and is approximately two hours long, covering primarily flat walking paths. Along the way, we will discuss canal landmarks

including Lock 62, the Odenbach Shipyard, the Auburn Railroad, the Village of Pittsford, the Pickle Factory and Oak Hill.

Participants should dress appropriately for the weather. Layer up and wear sturdy boots that you don't mind getting a little muddy. The Recreation Department will contact participants in advance with a meeting place and extra information prior to the hike date. They will also provide a trail map at the beginning of the hike. Bring your Wegmans Hit the Trail Passport and get credit for hiking the trail! The program is free but registration is required. 
PITTSFORD SPRING BUCKET LIST CHALLENGE

Pittsford Town Board meetings are being streamed live; the feed is accessible on any device. Town Board is typically held the first and third Tuesday of the month at 6:00pm at Town Hall. Please note: if you try to log in too early (before the meeting feed is live) you will see an error message; refresh your screen just prior to or at 6:00pm when the board meeting starts and you will be able to view the meeting. The Town of Pittsford has an American Sign Language interpreter available at every Pittsford Town Board meeting, to interpret for those who need this service. Those who can't attend a Town Board meeting in person but are planning to watch the meeting's live stream can confirm their need for the interpreter by


