#### Attend in person or online

The Pittsford Town Board continues to conduct meetings to discuss the Town's Zoning Code Update. The next meeting is **tomorrow**, **Thursday April 18** at **6:00pm** in the **Pittsford Community Library's** Fisher Meeting Room. **Please note**, **this is an updated date**, **time and location**. The Library is located at 24 State Street. <u>The meeting is open to the public and will be live streamed</u>.



#### Items for discussion include:

- Cluster zoning
- Zoning by Water Authority Property
- Consideration of the extension of Rural Residential South Pittsford (RRSP) zoning
- Consideration of Hillside zoning.

Public participation is important – the Board welcomes public comment! The public may comment on any aspect of rezoning, including items considered and discussed at previous meetings. > NARCAN TRAINING & SERVICES INFO AT LIBRARY NEXT WEDNESDAY, 4/24 - LEARN TO SAFELY STOP AN OPIOID OVERDOSE



The Pittsford Community Library will offer free public Narcan training and opioid awareness information next Wednesday, April 24 from 10:00am - 1:00pm in the Library hallway. Stop by to receive a free Narcan training and a Narcan kit from the Monroe County Health Department. Narcan (Naloxone) is a nasal spray that can be administered immediately to treat an opioid overdose. The opioid crisis continues at an alarming level. Approximately every other day, someone in Monroe County dies from an opioid overdose. There is no community immune to this crisis – learn how to save a life with Narcan. This drop-in program is free; no registration required.

#### HISTORIC PITTSFORD PRESERVATION AWARD NOMINATIONS DUE MAY 15

Historic Pittsford is seeking nominations for their annual <u>Historic Pittsford Preservation Achievement</u> <u>Award</u>; the deadline for nominations is May 15, 2024. The award recognizes an individual, group or organization that has made outstanding efforts that support Historic Pittsford's mission and make a significant contribution to historic preservation. Historic Pittsford provides leadership, advocacy and education to preserve Pittsford's diverse historic resources.

Historic Pittsford (HP) encourages and welcomes nominations from and for HP members and non-members alike. Nominees may include individuals, groups, organizations, businesses, students, scouts, governmental bodies, etc. Anyone can

make a nomination. The criteria for nomination and selection for each award category are below and may be found on the Historic Pittsford website at <a href="https://www.historicpittsford.com/preservation-achievement-awards">www.historicpittsford.com/preservation-achievement-awards</a>.

Submit a nomination for a Preservation Achievement Award in any one of the following categories:

**Stewardship Award** – for the sensitive preservation, restoration, rehabilitation or longterm maintenance and care of a historically significant property

**Advocacy Award** – for leadership of public or private efforts in support of historic preservation

**Education Award** – for the creation and implementation of programs, presentations, materials or educational activities which promote and support historic preservation

**Public Policy Award** – for the creation and approval of public policy which advances the principles of historic preservation

A committee from Historic Pittsford will screening and review the nominations; the Historic Pittsford Board of Directors will approve the final award decisions. The Preservation Achievement Awards will be presented at Historic Pittsford's Annual Meeting in July. #### AARP VOLUNTEERS PREPARE RECORD NUMBER OF TAX RETURNS FOR PITTSFORD SENIORS

Each year, the Pittsford Senior Center hosts a free volunteer-run AARP tax assistance and preparation service for senior citizens who live in the community. AARP tax preparation has wrapped up for the season, with volunteers assisting a record number of clients! Year-to-date, 503 returned were filed electronically, 17 via paper, and another 43 clients received answers to their tax-related questions. All-in-all, **a record 563 clients were served**! This free service saved our seniors \$182,000 in tax fees. In addition, AARP tax



volunteers helped seniors received \$206,000 in Federal and \$182,000 in New York State refunds. That adds up to \$518,000 in savings and refunds! We look forward to serving even MORE clients next year and would like to extend our sincere appreciation to Ron Brandwein from the AARP, along with his dedicated staff of volunteers.
