NEW ROAD, SIDEWALK AND SAFETY PROJECTS A Message from Town Supervisor Bill Smith

The Town has received federal funds for municipal improvements under the ARPA law. With the funds now remaining, the Town will undertake the following projects:

- State Street Median a traffic-calming median at the entrance to the Village that will provide safe crossing to the Canal Trail, approved by State DOT.
- Fairport Road Sidewalk connecting Alpine
 Drive to the pedestrian crossing at St. John Fisher's Murphy Hall, ensuring safe crossing and easy access to the Village for students
- Full milling and repaving of Turtle Creek
- Tobey Road Sidewalk Engineering work for planned sidewalk from Cricket Hill to Clover Street
- Purchase of four additional mounted speed radar units

My thanks to Town Staff and department heads for shaping these recommendations and thanks as well to the Town Board for its approval of them. As ever, we will continue to seek sources of funding for municipal improvements that spare Pittsford taxpayers from additional expense.

These initiatives follow on from projects the Town has already paid for, or approved, using ARPA funds, including:

Reservations due tomorrow, July 25



NARCAN TRAINING & SERVICES INFO AT LIBRARY THIS MONDAY, 7/29 - LEARN TO SAFELY STOP AN OPIOID OVERDOSE

The Pittsford Community Library will offer free public Narcan training and opioid awareness information this Monday, July 29 from 12:00pm - 3:00pm in the Library hallway. Stop by to receive a free Narcan training and a Narcan kit from the Monroe County Health Department. Narcan (Naloxone) is a nasal spray that can be administered immediately to treat an opioid overdose. The opioid crisis continues at an



alarming level. Approximately every other day, someone in Monroe County dies from an opioid overdose. There is no community immune to this crisis – learn how to save a life with Narcan. This drop-in program is free; no registration required.

KIDS' CONCERT WITH MR. LOOPS IS NEXT WEDNESDAY, JULY 31



ROCHESTER HEROES PUBLIC EXHIBIT & SCAVENGER HUNT AT PITTSFORD COMMUNITY LIBRARY

"Rochester Heroes" is an art exhibit featuring 32 pressboard historic figure silhouettes across 14 Monroe County Libraries. The Pittsford Community Library has the following figures on display: Garth Fagan, Sister Hieronymo O'Brien, Seth Green and Ellwanger and Barry. Learn more about the project on Greentopia's website. The exhibition was established in honor of the forthcoming High Falls State Park, a



massive project currently in development! The High Falls State Park will help to protect the Genesee River gorge and will give the public access to the base of the falls for the first time in over a century!

As part of the "Rochester Heroes" installation, Greentopia has organized a <u>scavenger hunt</u> featuring all 33 figures on display across fourteen Monroe County Libraries. Download or pick up a scavenger hunt sheet at the Library. Individuals who visit six libraries win a High Falls Park T-Shirt, and those who visit all fourteen libraries will receive a copy of "Reflections on the River," a book memorializing the project.

The figures will remain on display at the Library through the end of July and then will be sold in a public auction at the Rochester Central Library on August 1. All proceeds will go to support Greentopia's <u>Green Visions Workforce Development</u>.
