



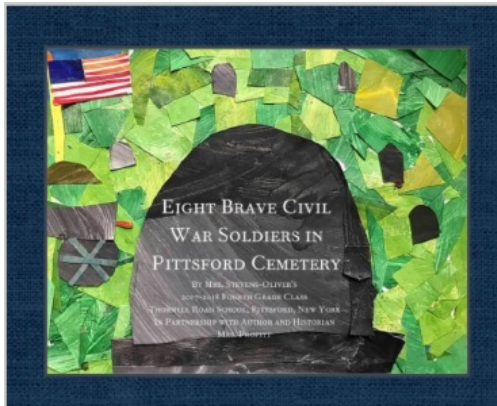

CIVIL WAR HISTORIC MARKER DEDICATION CEREMONY IS TOMORROW, 5/29

Everyone is invited to attend a ceremony dedicating a **Civil War Veterans Historic Marker** tomorrow, **May 29**, at **10:00am** in **Pittsford Cemetery**.

Advocacy for this new historic marker began in 2018 with the publication of "Eight Brave Soldiers in Pittsford Cemetery" by Thornell Road Elementary students in Mrs. Stevens-

Oliver's 2017-2018 4th-grade class. The class worked with and received research assistance from Town and Village of Pittsford Historian Vicki Masters Proffitt. Their hard work garnered them an award from the New York State Archives Partnership Trust, and a portion of the prize money will be used to plant flowers around the marker.

The dedication ceremony will take place in the center of the cemetery, near the flagpole. A light reception will follow. Pittsford Cemetery is located at 38 Washington Road in the Village of Pittsford. Join us!

SPRING CLEANING RECYCLE DROP IS JUNE 7 – FREE FOR PITTSFORD RESIDENTS

Clean out your closets and garage without filling up the landfill! To make it easier to get rid of items you can't put in the trash, the Town has organized a **Spring Cleaning Drop** on **Saturday, June 7**, from **9:00am to noon** at **Pittsford Mendon High School**. It's free for Pittsford residents! Town staff will collect electronics, scrap metal, and paint for recycling. We'll provide secure document shredding as well. Women's Club of Pittsford volunteers will collect clothing items and linens.

Electronics Recycling

- **Accepted items include:** computers and computer accessories (keyboards, mice, etc.), laptops, mobile devices, printers, video, audio and stereo equipment, televisions, wiring, cables and **rechargeable batteries**
- **Not accepted:** please do NOT bring small or large appliances; we cannot accept toasters, vacuum cleaners, coffee makers, hair dryers, irons, stoves,

refrigerators, air conditioners, washers, dryers, etc., or *non-rechargeable batteries*

Paint Recycling

- Paints, primers, stains, sealers and clear coatings such as shellac and varnish will be accepted
- Must be in the original container with original label, covered with a secure lid
- Please do NOT bring aerosol coatings/spray paint, solvents and industrial/non-architectural use paints

Scrap Metal Recycling

- Accepting various metal items made of steel, stainless steel, iron, cast iron, copper, brass, or aluminum – including siding and gutters, wires, pipes, electrical components, insulated wires, sheet metal and other items made of metal (no large appliances)

Certified Document Shredding

- Secure shredding, personal/residential documents only
- No need to remove staples or paper clips

Clothing Donations

- Used clothing, shoes, sneakers, belts, purses, linens, pillowcases, blankets and curtains will be accepted
- Through their partnership with St. Pauly Textile, the Women's Club of Pittsford will be paid for all clothing items and linens collected; these funds will support a variety of charitable efforts in Pittsford
- St. Pauly Textile ensures usable clothing gets to those who can use it – locally, nationally and internationally
- Items that are no longer wearable/usable will be recycled

Get rid of those unneeded items you can't easily dispose of. Keep them off the landfill and put them to good use instead! Stop by the Town's Spring Cleaning Drop on June 7, 2025, from 9:00am to noon. Pittsford Mendon High School is located at 472 Mendon Road.

HISTORIC PITTSFORD WINS NEW YORK STATE PRESERVATION AWARD

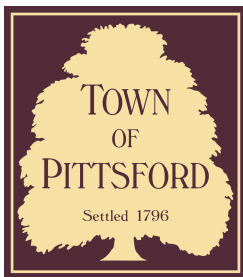
Great news for the Pittsford community! Historic Pittsford has received the prestigious New York State Historic Preservation Award for Excellence in Non-Profit Achievement. This annual award, presented by the New York State Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation, recognizes outstanding contributions to historic preservation throughout the state.



Celebrating its 60th anniversary this year, Historic Pittsford was commended for its significant impact on the quality of life in both the Village and Town of Pittsford. The award specifically acknowledged the organization's strong advocacy for preservation and open space conservation, along with its public programs, resources and documentation efforts.

Founded in 1965 to save the historic Little House, Historic Pittsford has played a crucial role in shaping our community. Their efforts have resulted in achievements such as the designation of a village historic district, the rehabilitation of many historic buildings, the preservation of our village high school, the construction of the village library and the redevelopment of the Erie Canal waterfront.

The dedication and continuous advocacy of Historic Pittsford were key factors in receiving this distinguished award. Congratulations to Historic Pittsford's Board members and volunteers! You make our Town better, and for that, we thank you.

ASL INTERPRETER ALWAYS AVAILABLE AT TOWN BOARD MEETINGS

The Town of Pittsford has an American Sign Language interpreter available at every Pittsford Town Board meeting, to interpret for those who need this service. Those who can't attend a Town Board meeting in person but are planning to watch the meeting's live stream can confirm their need for the interpreter by emailing comments@townofpittsford.org. Requests can be made in advance or can be emailed through the first ten minutes of the meeting.
