

This year, all outdoor movies will be held at the Spiegel Community Center field.


Our first Thursday evening Family Outdoor Movie Night of the season is **tomorrow, Thursday, July 10**, featuring **MOANA 2** [PG].

Specific needs for the Oak Tree Food Pantry include items that can be easily prepared by students, including soups, canned meats and vegetables, and sauces. The pantry also needs granola bars, pasta, peanut butter, soap, and other hygiene products.
