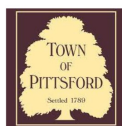
We'll have the **Kona Ice** food truck on site for cool treats on a warm evening!

## SUPPORT REFUGEES AT THE SAINT'S PLACE SUPER SALE AUGUST 5 - 8

One of Pittsford's most popular charity events returns this August! The annual Saint's Place Super Sale will be held from August 5 - 8 at the St. John of Rochester Parish Center gym, located at 10 Wickford Way in Fairport. The sale, which previously took place at St. Louis Church in Pittsford, is now in its second year at the current location.

This large indoor sale features thousands of high-quality new and gently used items, including clothing, jewelry, electronics, toys,

furniture, sporting goods, home décor and more, all donated by the community. Proceeds support [Saint's Place](#), a local nonprofit that assists legal refugees with essential items, including beds, warm winter clothing, household furnishings, and educational support.

Funds from the sale also fuel the [Saint's Place Educational Initiative](#), which has provided nearly \$300,000 in tuition assistance, computers, driving lessons, and English tutoring for almost 300 refugees since 2018.

"Helping refugees, especially women, gain education and employment has a powerful ripple effect on families and communities," said Michele Quinn, Executive Director.

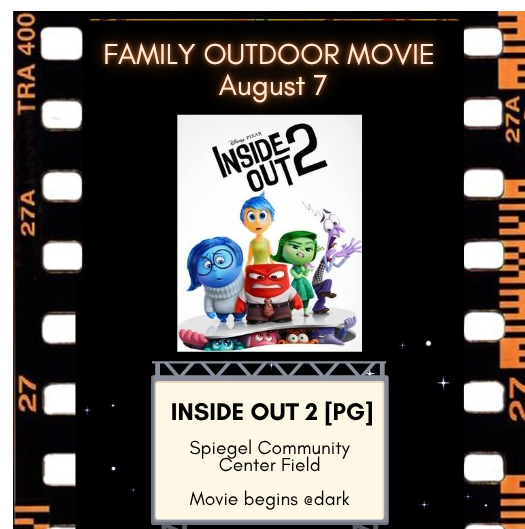

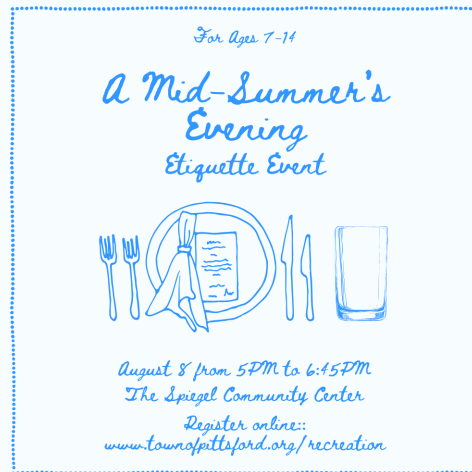

### PITTSFORD ROTARY FOOD DRIVE THIS SATURDAY, 9AM – 12PM

The Rotary Club of Pittsford's next food drive is scheduled for this Saturday, August 2, from 9:00am-noon at the Pittsford Sutherland High School bus loop. In addition to the **Pittsford Food Cupboard**, donations will support the Community Food Cupboard of Rochester and the Nazareth University Oak Tree Food Pantry. *Gently used recent issues (past 12 months) of magazines will also be collected for distribution to various social agencies in the Rochester area.*

The [Pittsford Food Cupboard](#) serves those needing food within our community. Donations help ensure that local families have access to essential food items that will promote well-being and stability. Items especially needed include any bags you can spare, shampoo, conditioner, body wash, toothpaste, taco shells, spaghetti sauce, canned tomatoes (crushed, whole, or pureed – no diced), pudding or Jell-O, jelly or jam, rice sides, pasta and any canned protein. They currently have no room for corn, black beans, white beans or green beans.

[The Community Food Cupboard of Rochester](#) is a non-profit food cupboard dedicated to feeding hungry families and home-bound senior citizens in Northeast Rochester and Irondequoit.

[The Oak Tree Pantry](#) serves those needing food within the Nazareth University community. Specific needs for the Oak Tree Food Pantry include items that can be easily prepared by students, including soups, canned meats and vegetables and sauces. The pantry also needs granola bars, pasta, peanut butter, soap, and other hygiene products.
