
My best wishes for a merry Christmas and a happy Chanukah! May we remember and appreciate the meanings of these celebrations as we gather together with family, friends and loved ones.





CHRISTMAS & NEW YEAR'S HOURS FOR TOWN FACILITIES

In observance of the Christmas holiday, Town offices (including Town Hall, Town Court, and the Parks, Sewer, and Highway departments), will be closed on Wednesday, 12/25. Town Hall and Town Court will remain closed the day after Christmas, Thursday, 12/26. All offices will reopen on Friday, 12/27.





Community Center will resume regular hours, 8:00am-6:00pm, on Thursday, 12/26. The Pittsford Community Library will be closed on Tuesday, 12/24, Wednesday, 12/25, and Thursday, 12/26. The Library will be open regular hours (9:00am-8:00pm) on Friday, 12/27.

In observance of the New Year's holiday, Town Hall and Town Court will close at 12:00pm on Tuesday, 12/31 and all Town offices (including Town Hall, Town Court, and the Parks, Sewer, and Highway departments) will be closed on Wednesday, 1/1/25.

The Spiegel Pittsford Community Center will be closed on Tuesday, 12/31 and Wednesday, 1/1/25. Regular hours will resume on Thursday, 1/2/25 (8:00am-9:00pm).

The Pittsford Community Library will close early at 5:00pm on Tuesday, 12/31, will be closed on Wednesday, 1/1/25, and will resume regular hours (9:00am – 8:00pm) on Thursday, 1/2/2025.

Materials and instruction are available while supplies last. All ages are welcome; the craft is best for children ages 3-7. Don't forget to check out a few books to read over break!

On Monday, December 30, the Library is hosting two winter dance parties! Dance to your heart's content in the Fisher Meeting Room from 10:00 - 10:30am and

again from 11:00 - 11:30am, and are best for ages 2 - 5, though all are welcome. No registration required.

The Library will close early at 5:00pm on Tuesday, December 31, and will remain closed January 1.

In the past, the Library has run several successful break-in room events. The high demand has led to additional time slots over three days so that even more can participate! Come Monday, December 30, Thursday, January 2, or Friday, January 3 to see if you can solve the puzzles, open the locks, and break into the box before the clock strikes midnight. Each 20-minute time slot of the "Countdown to Midnight Break-In Room" accommodates groups of 2 - 6. Register for individual sessions through the Library's online program calendar. The challenge is best for ages 7 and up, but all are welcome.

Then, on **Saturday, January 4**, stop into the Children's Room during open hours, find the hidden characters and win a prize when you participate in a **kid-friendly scavenger hunt!** All are welcome, no registration required.


Those interested in applying for a grant can <u>fill out a grant application online</u>. Applications must be received no later than December 31, 2024.



The online application submission must include a copy of the letter from the IRS advising that your organization has 501(c)(3) status. The Women's Club of Pittsford is unable to support organization that do not send verification of 501(c)(3) status. The Women's Club will notify grant recipients in May.

<u>The Women's Club of Pittsford</u> is a part of the General Federation of Women's Clubs (GFWC). They are a local, non-profit, voluntary organization that offers opportunities

Pittsford Town Board meetings are being streamed live; the feed is accessible on any device. Town Board is typically held the first and third Tuesday of the month at 6:00pm at Town Hall. See www.townofpittsford.org/calendar for meeting dates. To view the livestream, click the Town Board Meeting live streaming link when the meeting begins. This link can also be found on page two of the meeting agenda. The meeting agenda is posted on the Town's

minutes and agendas page at least two days prior to the meeting. Please note: if you try to log in too early (before the meeting feed is live) you will see an error message; refresh your screen just prior to or at 6:00pm when the board meeting starts and you will be able to view the meeting. As always, ASL interpretation is provided for every Town Board meeting.

ASL INTERPRETER ALWAYS AVAILABLE AT TOWN BOARD MEETINGS

The Town of Pittsford has an American Sign Language interpreter available at every Pittsford Town Board meeting, to interpret for those who need this service. Those who can't attend a Town Board meeting in person but are planning to watch the meeting's live stream can confirm their need for the interpreter by emailing comments@townofpittsford.org. Requests can be made in advance or can be emailed through the first ten minutes of the meeting. An on-demand Town Board meeting video with closed captioning will be available within 48 hours of the meeting; visit www.townofpittsford.org/channel12 and use the On-Demand links to view previously recorded meetings.
