10TH ANNUAL WREATHS ACROSS AMERICA CEREMONY THIS TUESDAY, DECEMBER 2

Each December, millions of volunteers across the country take part in *Wreaths Across America*, a national effort to honor and remember our nation's service members. Participants gather at cemeteries and memorials in all 50 states, as well as at sea and abroad, to pay tribute to veterans, activeduty military personnel, and their families.

This year, the Women's Club of Pittsford, Rayson-Miller American Legion Post 899, and Gallea's Florist and Greenhouse will once again bring this meaningful tradition to our community. The organizations will host Pittsford's local Wreaths Across America Ceremony this Tuesday, December 2, 2025, at

3:00pm sharp at the Pittsford Veterans Monument in Carpenter Park at the Port of Pittsford (22 N. Main Street).

Now in its 10th year, Pittsford's ceremony reflects the community's longstanding support of Wreaths Across America's mission to "Remember the fallen, Honor those who serve, and Teach the next generation the value of freedom." Two live evergreen wreaths, provided by Gallea's Florist, will be placed at the Veterans Monument as a living memorial, symbolizing respect, gratitude, and remembrance. The wreaths will remain on display through January 2.

The ceremony will feature the singing of the National Anthem, recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance, participation by the Rayson-Miller Color Guard, and remarks from representatives of the Women's Club of Pittsford, Town Supervisor Bill Smith, and Village Mayor Alysa Subtlety Plummer. The event will conclude with the playing of "Taps."

Stop by and enjoy complimentary cookies and cider, available while supplies last. Town staff will be on hand to greet residents and visitors as part of this festive community tradition.






