


# **2022 Highway Department**Project Funding Requests

#### **Additional Road Maintenance**

- Increase in Asphalt Prices ~20%
- Preventive Maintenance Costs ~28%
  - Increase in Oil Prices
  - Increase in Stone Prices
- Increase in Trucking
- Increase in Contractor Costs
  - Monroe County DOT reports Contracts up ~15%
- Additional Maintenance of Cemetery Roads
- Adding 3 more roads for full repaving this year

Estimated Additional Funds - \$412,000



#### **Brickston Drive Culvert Repairs**


- Installed in 1978
- Corrugated Metal Pipe
- Drop Catch Basins over pipe adding to its deterioration
- Sinkholes
- Cul-de-Sac Limits Type of Repair
- Re-Line Complete
   Neighborhood system

Project Estimate - \$32,000



## **Colonial Parkway Culvert Repairs**

- Constructed in 1963
- Town-owned road
- Stone Veneer and Wall Caps falling off due to age of structural headwall












## **Sidewalk Improvements**

- Replace 1980's Asphalt Sidewalk
- Currently <u>not</u> ADA-Compliant
- Replace with Concrete
- Make fully ADA-Compliant
- Replace Asphalt Sidewalk on S. Main: Village Line to Reitz Parkway
  - Provide connection to newly-installed Pedestrian Crossing
- Additional Spot Sidewalk Repairs around

Project Estimate - \$125,000








#### **Fleet Maintenance**


- Deferred Purchases due to COVID
- Long Delivery Timeframes for Equipment
- Increase Costs in Parts and Contracted
   Services

- Salt Barn Preventive Maintenance
- Roof and Rain Gutter Repairs
   Estimated Additional Funds \$9,000
