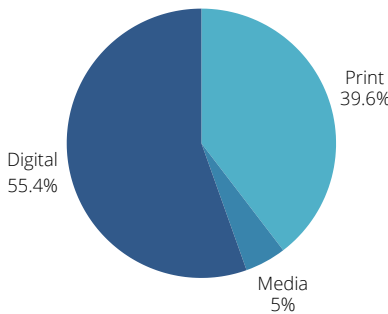
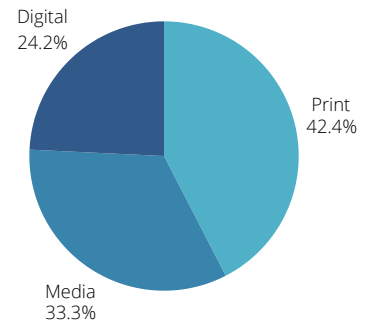

Collection Holdings by Format

In response to community needs and interests, PCL provides a high-quality collection of books and other materials in a variety of formats. In 2024, PCL reported 285,322 items in its print, media, and digital collections. 79% of the 2024 community survey respondents said access to downloadable books and audiobooks is important.



Collection & Resource Use by Format

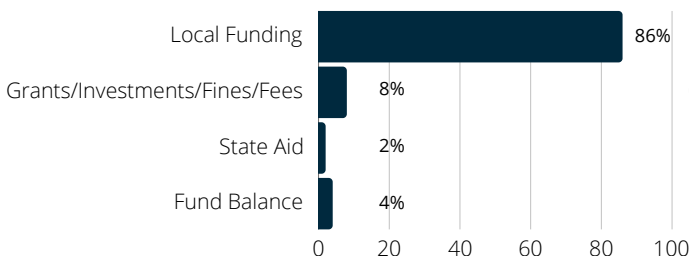
548,103 items were checked out from PCL's print, media, and digital collections.

445,300 news pages were viewed through PCL's digital newspaper access. 72% of the 2024 community survey respondents said digital newspaper access is an important resource.

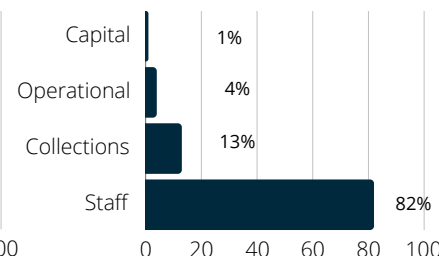
