

PEDDLER AND SOLICITORS PERMITS

The suspension of permits previously instituted due to the Coronavirus has been lifted and Peddlers and Solicitors are being permitted to resume their business, following the necessary guidelines as outlined by the State of New York. If you do not want solicitation to occur at your door, you can post a “No Solicitation” sign on your property (on the door, a window or in your yard), and the solicitor must adhere to the sign or their permit can be revoked.

NOTE: If a solicitor comes to your door and they are **NOT** listed below, please call the Town Code Enforcement (585-248-6260) to report immediately, with the name of the company and the street name of where they are soliciting. If it is not during business hours, you may call the Monroe County Sheriff's 911 number and say it is a “non-emergency call” to report. Please leave a message with the Town also.

*Not-for-Profits – are not required to obtain a Permit nor notify the Town. However, if they do notify the Town, they will be on our list. They may be soliciting or going door-to-door for their organization and/or governmental agency's work. They are required to abide by the Pittsford Town Code, Chapter 112 – Peddlers and Solicitors.
