EMERGENCY ORDER

I, Adam J. Bello, County Executive of the County of Monroe, in accordance with a declaration of a State of Emergency issued on March 14, 2020 and renewed on April 10, 2020, and pursuant to Article 2B, Section 24, of the New York State Executive Law, do hereby extend the Emergency Order dated April 20, 2020, and ORDER:

To protect life and help bring the emergency under control by reducing the number of individuals entering municipal office buildings, I hereby prohibit the in-person payment of Monroe County real property taxes in County and town facilities during this State of Emergency.

The following provisions shall be made to carry out the intent of this Order:

- 1. To decrease the need for in-person assistance, reduce demand on municipal employees responding to disaster relief efforts, and continue to encourage taxpayers to make payments remotely, Monroe County real property tax payments made on or before May 31, 2020, including third and/or fourth installment payments, partial payments, and final payments made pursuant to Sections 673-14g or 14h of the Monroe County Tax Act, shall be subject an interest rate of 3%;
- 2. Monroe County will absorb user fees charged for online payments made through the County's vendor;
- 3. The Monroe County Department of Finance is directed to install a lockbox in the County Office Building for collecting property tax payments; and
- 4. Payment of Monroe County real property taxes shall continue to be accepted by mail.

This Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in effect for five days unless rescinded earlier by my order.
