- **Resume Regular Hours:** Friday, January 2

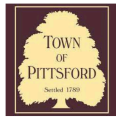

### PROPERTY TAX BILLS AND INFORMATION

If you are not in escrow, you should receive your 2026 Town and County tax bill in the mail this week.

If you do not receive your bill in the mail by January 10, you can obtain a copy of your bill by either:



- 1) Downloading and printing a copy directly from the [Monroe County website](#).
- 2) Calling the Town Tax Office at 585-248-6215 or emailing the Town Clerk/Tax Receiver at: [townclerk@townofpittsford.org](mailto:townclerk@townofpittsford.org), and they will email a copy of the bill to you.

The interest-free Town and County property tax payment deadline is 2/10; first installments are also accepted on or before 2/10. Please be sure to read all the instructions and information written on the back of your bill carefully. **Please include your payment coupon (page 2 of your bill) and a contact phone number on your check.** Failure to do so increases processing time.

#### How to make your payment:

- **By mail to:** Renee McQuillen, Receiver, 11 South Main Street, Pittsford, NY 14534
- **In person,** Monday through Friday, 8:00am to 4:00pm at Pittsford Town Hall, 11 South Main Street, or through the mail slots (into locked boxes) available 24/7, located at both the front and back entrances.

\*For cash payments, we ask that you bring the exact amount, and please call ahead for an appointment to ensure we have proper staffing.

- **First Installments and full payments only** can also be made at Canandaigua National Bank, 18 State Street, in Pittsford Village through February 10, 2026.
- **Online through Monroe County by credit card, check, or debit card.** Please note there is a 2.75% fee to pay by credit card and a sliding scale fee to pay by



check debit. To pay online, click [HERE](#).

- As in the past, **we strongly advise that you do NOT pay by electronic check.** These payments do not receive a U.S. postmark and may arrive late. If you choose to pay your tax bill through your bank's online bill pay (electronic banking) system, please be aware that your bank still generates and mails a paper check to the Town, and it may take up to 2 weeks to reach the Town offices. This type of mail does not receive a USPS postmark. Therefore, the Town can only consider your payment received on the date it is physically received in our office. If the payment is received past the deadline, it will be considered late and will accrue interest penalties.

**BLOOD DRIVE AT THE LIBRARY THIS FRIDAY, 1/2**

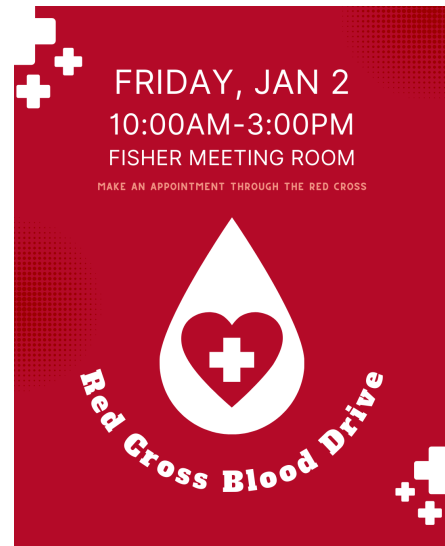
