Town Liaison Report

- Naveen Havannavar reported for Town Board.
  - Senior property tax exemption was approved.
  - The Stormwater Intermunicipal Agreement was renewed for 2026.
  - 2026 logistics and infrastructure support for events and recreation programming was approved.
  - The Village of East Rochester was designated the State Environmental Quality Review Lead Agency for the annexation petition.
  - The bid for the State Street Meridian Project was approved.
  - A capital expenditure for Kings Bend Park playground construction was authorized.

#### Director Report

- Amanda K. Madigan's director report on library activities and events was emailed for review prior to the meeting.
- **Amanda requested a motion to approve the rescheduling of the morning library closure for staff training to Friday, October 23<sup>rd</sup>. Chris Hall moved to approve the closure and Dan English seconded. Motion carried.**
- **The 2026 FFRPL grant was presented. Radhika Ramesh motioned for Board President Lori Lusk as the designated signature. Marcia Layton Turner seconded the motion which was approved.**

#### New Business

- Amanda K. Madigan shared an update for the 2025 Town of Pittsford budget.
- Marcia Layton Turner presented the Pittsford Community Library Foundation report. This year's gift was designated at \$ 55,000.
- **Amanda requested a motion to approve a foundation request for \$1,800.00 for a Causewave survey in preparation for the Long Range Plan Committee. Dan English moved to approve, and Radhika Ramesh seconded the request. Motion carried.**
