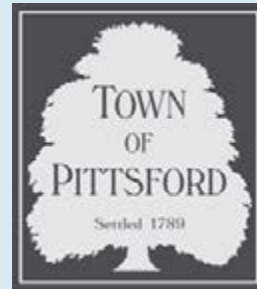

This season's programs and events are thoughtfully designed to bring residents of all ages together to create cherished shared experiences. From lively family festivals and outdoor adventures to enriching learning opportunities and friendly social gatherings, there are so many ways to embrace and enjoy the season together.

We've been busy planning BIG events for spring 2026, and we invite you to save the dates. On Saturday, May 30, from 10:00am to 12:00pm, families can gather at the Pittsford Community Center parking lot for **Meet the Machines**, a favorite annual event where children can get an up-close look at the trucks and equipment they see working around town every day. It's a fun, hands-on way for the community to come together.

Our popular Story Strolls return to the Pittsford Community Center this spring, offering a simple way to enjoy reading, fresh air, and time together. Families are invited to stroll through the field and read **When Spring Comes** (April 13-19), **The Sour Grape** (May 11-17), and **And Then Comes Summer** (June 8-14). After finishing each story, stop by the front desk to pick up a fun craft bag to take home.

As the weather warms, the community gathers once again along the canal for **Paddle and Pour** on Saturday, May 23, from noon to 10:00pm. This signature Pittsford event celebrates the start of summer with live music, New York State beer and wine, great food from local eateries, unique shopping opportunities, and the excitement of Pittsford Crew's annual regatta. Community traditions continue with the **Memorial Day Parade** on Monday, May 25, stepping off at 10:00am. The parade begins on Sutherland Street, proceeds down Jefferson Road to South Main Street, and ends at the Pittsford Cemetery. This long-standing event brings residents together to honor and remember those who gave their lives in service to our country.

Our Canalside concert on **Juneteenth**, Friday, June 19, features nationally renowned jazz saxophonist **Judah Sealy**, followed by Juneteenth events the next day. And in this year of America's 250th birthday, Pittsford will be celebrating that milestone and the founding of our country with special events on and around the **Fourth of July**.

Spring also marks the time to start planning for summer adventures. **Summer FUN Camp** for ages 5-13 runs from June 29 through August 21 at the Pittsford Community Center and Thornell Road Elementary School, featuring a new theme each week and plenty of opportunities for kids to make friends and try new activities. Younger children ages 3-5 can enjoy **Summer FUN Juniors** at the Pittsford Community Center, offered in morning or afternoon sessions with playful, age-appropriate themes that encourage creativity and social connection.

NON-RESIDENT FEE: Participants living outside of the Town of Pittsford and the Pittsford School District are required to pay a \$5.00 per activity registration fee (per individual registrant). No fee is required for free programs. Programs offered are designed for residents of the Town of Pittsford and Pittsford School District. If class size allows, registrations from non-residents who have paid the non-resident fee will be accepted. Participants living outside of the Town of Pittsford and Pittsford School District may register to receive our program brochures by mail by contacting the Recreation Department. There is a \$3.00 fee charged for outside mailing.

REFUND POLICY: Refunds are available, unless otherwise stated in the program description. All refund requests must be submitted to the Pittsford Recreation Department. If a program is canceled, total amount will be refunded. You may withdraw up to 7 calendar days prior to the start of a program; a refund will be granted with a **\$5 processing fee per person/per program** (certain programs may be nonrefundable or involve a portion of nonrefundable monies.) Within one week of a program's start date, or after a program has begun, only medical refunds will be granted. A doctor's written statement must accompany your request. Refund will be prorated based on the date of your notification to the Recreation Department. Absolutely no refunds will be granted after the program ends.

REGISTRATION TIPS: Programs that do not meet the minimum number of participants are subject to cancellation. Assume you are registered in the program unless the recreation department notifies you. Please remember that some of our programs fill quickly so please register early.

RELEASE: As part of my registration, or as a parent/guardian on behalf of a minor child, I recognize that programs involving physical activity have inherent risks of injury and/or damage and I assume all such risks, as well as the responsibility to be fully aware of the inherent risks associated with any program for which I register, before I begin participation. I also recognize my participation in a program may result in the transfer or transmission of an illness or disease, including but not limited to COVID-19, which could result in serious sickness and/or death. The Town and its employees will not be liable for injury, damage or illness that occurs as a result of such risks and I waive and release the Town and its employees from any such liability. I also grant full permission to the Town to use my name, photograph, videotape or recording for any publicity promotion purposes without obligation or liability.
